Intersections are high-risk locations for collisions

According to the Government of Alberta, every year on average:

- 66 people die at intersections
- 8,000 people are injured

According to the RCMP, factors that lead to accidents at intersections are:

- Unsafe left turns
- Violating traffic signals
- Speeding are factors in intersection accidents

Intersection Safety Tips

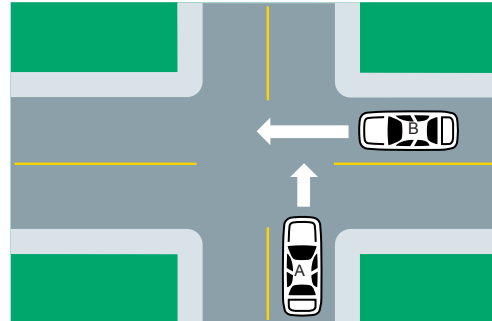
- ✓ Obey traffic signs and signals. Make a full stop at red lights and stop signs, even when turning right.
- ✓ Pedestrians have the right of way in all marked or unmarked crosswalks. Before making a turn, ensure pedestrians have cleared the crosswalk.

Intersection Safety Tips

- ✓ At a three and four-way stops, remember the Right of Way rule. The vehicle that arrived first should proceed first. If two vehicles arrive at the same time, the vehicle on the right should proceed first



A yields to B: This intersection has no signs or signals and B is to the right of A.
